




Effective February 25, 2016 we will begin accepting email communications and notifications to AAA9 staff as well as fax and other written communications.


















Only initiate E-mail to unit sites and not individual staff.

 - AAA9 is required to abide by Ohio Sunshine Law regulations. Our corporate email is a public document and, once sent, is the property of AAA9 and not the employee.
 - Use the appropriate forms (attachment)

- What information can be communicated via email:
- Routine Information
- Bid requests
- Falls without injuries
- Initial referral acceptance or decline
- Permanent changes with approval of case manager
- Reassessment continuation/routine service orders
- Service adjustments
- Temporary changes

What information can NOT be communicated via email:

- Time-sensitive Information
 - Any suspicion/report of abuse, neglect or exploitation
 - Change in mental status
 - Decline in health status or any significate change
 - Drug/illegal activity
 - Falls with injury
 - Health and safety issues
 - Hospital/nursing facility admissions and/or discharges
 - Request for approvals of additional services
 - Thefts
 - Transportation request

This is a new process for AAA9 and we consider it a pilot. During the startup we would welcome your feedback and suggestions for improvement.

Often times your forms you use are very well organized or designed. We may tweak our process as we go.

Always take every precaution to protect personal health information (phi) and conform with HIPAA rules.
