Individuals age 60 and over	 Income for primary applicant and all household members 18 years of age or older Social Security Numbers for primary applicant and all household members Most recent electric and gas bills Proof of citizenship for all household members 	 Electric Utility Assistance: Up to \$300 for regulated utility customers Up to \$500 for unregulated utility customers Indoor Air Quality & Comfort Assistance: Up to \$500 for central air conditioning repair, Up to \$175 for air-conditioner units, or up to \$70 per fan (maximum 2 fans) Total benefit cannot exceed \$500
