## About Maximum Accessible Housing of Ohio:

Through housing, advocacy, and education, MAHO advances accessible and inclusive communities where all people can thrive. Established in 1981, MAHO is the leading provider of and advocate for accessible housing. We have two primary programs: the Vistas Apartment Communities and the Anderson Center for Accessible Living.

## Vistas Apartment Communities:

We own and operate five fully accessible apartment communities in Northeast Ohio for people with physical mobility disabilities. All of the Vistas Apartments are subsidized so tenants pay only 30 percent of their income toward rent. These communities have 24 to 40 one- and two-bedroom units. All units and common areas are designed for full accessibility, including wheelchair-accessible kitchens and bathrooms. They are all located near shopping areas and public transportation.

## Anderson Center for Accessible Living:

Through the Anderson Center, we provide much-needed training and information on accessible housing. This program serves many audiences, including people with disabilities and seniors, their families and caregivers, and social service and housing professionals. Activities include educational workshops, tours of our fully accessible Demonstration Unit, and [www.accessibleliving.org](http://www.accessibleliving.org), a comprehensive website designed for the consumer.

- every person's home meets their accessibility needs;
- every community is welcoming and inclusive to all residents and visitors; and
